RE: SNA LU Gateway Billing Change

The purpose of this communication is to advise you of an important billing change related to SNA LU Gateway charges, which are incurred for all users of the AT&T Passport and AT&T TN3270 services.

Effective November 1st, 2010, all billing for SNA LU Gateway Access will change from a usage-based hourly fee to a per-connection attempt fee.

Current Billing: \$4.25 Per hour
Revised Billing: .30 cents per Connection

What this means is each time you connect to the AT&T SNA network using either AT&T's Passport client or any other TN3270 client, this fee will apply. Please be aware that the AT&T network has an inactivity timeout of 5 minutes. To reduce connection fees, you may want to consider consolidating your work so you will require less connection attempts to the network.

Additionally, if you have a scripted program that connects to the SNA network automatically, we suggest that you review it to minimize connection attempts.
