| <b>State</b>        | <b>Question</b>  | <b>Response</b>  |

| <b>Arizona</b>      | Asked about approach being taken to get junk, salvage, and insurance information by March 31 <sup>st</sup> . | <b>AAMVA:</b> Will be authorizing a number of entities to serve as “data consolidators”. They would operate under contract with AAMVA. The Consolidator will collect the data that must be reported by junk and salvage yards and insurance carriers then transmitted the data to AAMVA as the operator.   |
| <b>Arizona</b>      | Enforcement of data provided by junk, salvage, and insurance companies                                       | <b>DOJ-</b> In the Anti Car Theft Act, there is a \$1000 fine for each violation. DOJ preserves its full enforcement authority and discretion, including the ability to determine what constitutes a violation of the Act.   |
| <b>South Dakota</b> | How are you identifying those that should be reporting?  | <b>AAMVA/DOJ:</b> Unique identifier for each reporting entity. DOJ responsible for getting entities to report. States <u>could</u> help with this. DOJ is working with various associations and data consolidators to identify those that should be reporting. DOJ said states have no responsibilities as it related to reporting by JSI entities. Need to develop a standardized message in case states get questions. |



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| <b>South Dakota</b>   | Will slides be available?                           | <i>AAMVA:</i> Yes, after the presentations on Tuesday. We will posted the summary of the questions/answers that we covered during today's call as well as tomorrow's.   |
| <b>Arizona</b>        | Junk and salvage reporting requirements for states? | <i>DOJ -</i> No change in state reporting requirements.   |
| <b>South Dakota</b>   | Which insurance claims must be reported?            | <i>DOJ -</i> Total loss and salvage   |
| <b>North Carolina</b> | Are there penalties for non-compliance?             | <i>DOJ -</i> No monetary penalties for States are prescribed in the Act.  |
| <b>Pennsylvania</b>   | Will states be required to pay dues?                | <i>DOJ -</i> Yes, by January 1, 2010  |
| <b>Pennsylvania</b>   | What will be the 2010 user fee and structure?       | <i>AAMVA:</i> Given that the rule states that the operator must give states 12 month notice. Yes, the current 10 tier structure and fees will remain for 2010. For FY2011, not yet been determined but will get something out in the coming weeks |



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| <b>Nebraska</b>     | When would new fee be effective?  | <i>AAMVA</i> – The current fees will remain in effect for FY2010.  |
| <b>Pennsylvania</b> | AAMVA technical folks and contacts available for states that start development? | <i>AAMVA:</i> Yes, Marney Michalowski <a href="mailto:mmichalowski@aamva.org">mmichalowski@aamva.org</a> is the initial contact point for states wanted to begin discussions with AAMVA on development.  |
| <b>California</b>   | How will “name” work?   | <i>AAMVA:</i> We had hoped to not “store” the name on NMVTIS and allow it to be passed by the state of record to the inquiring entity. For online states, the field already exists as part of the state to state inquiry, but is currently optional. It will have to become mandatory and name can then be shared by online states as part of the state to state inquiry. The issue is how we handle the “name” as part of batch provision. Still need to complete assessment and finalize solutions. We expect to work with States as we normally do to find those solutions that would work. |
| <b>California</b>   | Status of standalone inquiry?   | <i>AAMVA:</i> We are currently focused in meeting the due date of March 31, 2009 for implementation of reporting by junk, salvage and insurance. Once that work is complete we will focus all of our attention on standalone and explore opportunities to implement it a timely and effective manner that will satisfy our member needs.   |



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
