

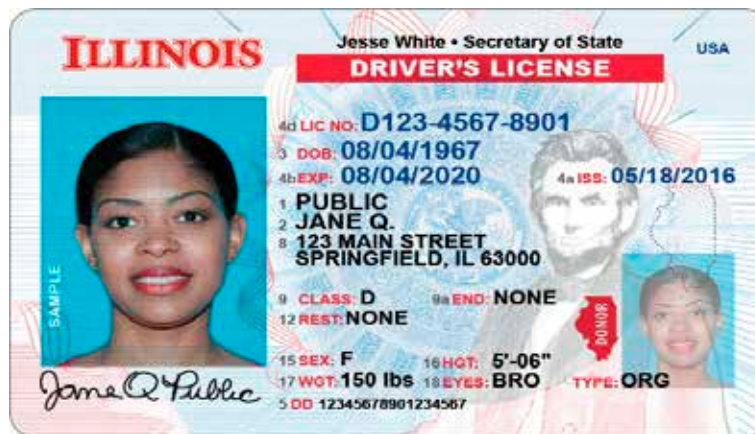


Illinois

Jurisdictional Showcase

- Beginning with January 2017 registrations
- 10% each year
- Will start with oldest plates on the road
- Passenger vehicles only (trucks in 2018)
- Will allow for a continuous replating every 10 years for all vehicles

- Began rollout in May 2016
- Moved from instant issue to central issue
- New security features
- Over 1 million cards mailed



Free ID Card for Foster Kids

- SB 2524, Public Act 99-0659
- Free one time only at initial issuance
- For children between the ages of 16-21 who reside in foster care or are under the jurisdiction of DCFS
- Applicant must provide signed SOS pre-approved affidavit form or affidavit from court-appointed attorney.
- SOS currently supplies free cards for the homeless, veterans' home residents, applicants over the age of 65, active duty military and family (duplicates only)

Wallet Cards for PWD

- House Bill 4257, Public Act 99-0829
- Must inform applicant of the availability of the card
- Applicants with Type 2 (developmental) or Type 5 (mental) disabilities.
- Help with interaction with law enforcement and others because of the card holder's inability to communicate effectively due to disability (i.e., autism, asperbergers, stroke victims)
- Working with IL Department of Human Services on design and production.
