This interactive Guide provides information on the application process for Regular and Commercial (CDL) driver licenses and Identification (ID) cards. The Guide will determine your eligibility, provide you with a checklist of requirements, and allow you to pre-fill any required application(s). Depending on your eligibility, you may also be able to use this Guide to electronically submit your application(s) and schedule an appointment with the DMV.

By providing your personal identifying information in this Guide, we will be able to search for your DMV record and provide you with more accurate and complete information. You may also obtain general information through an anonymous search.

2016 Enhancements:

- } ID cards added
- } Forms became fillable and savable
- } Customer can print form with bar code OR
- } Electronically transmit to DMV
- } Customers can schedule an appointment with DMV CSC



Ways CSC process forms:

- } Customer completes application and prints with bar code
 - § Normal processing and wait time
- } Customer completes application and files electronically and prints (optional)
 - § Customer presents bar code at CSC or agent looks up
 - § Saves time on visit – populates application
 - § May reduce keying errors
- } Customer completes application, files electronically and schedules appointment
 - § High priority queue for service
 - § Currently 5 stations accept appointments, increasing to 30

eNotify - Go paperless: Receive DMV notifications via email

Go paperless and receive many of your DMV notices by email through our eNotify (electronic notification) program. You can also set up text reminders for your mobile devices.

Subscribing to this service will allow you to get the following notifications via email:

- License plate registration renewals for all **eligible vehicles**
- Driver License or ID renewals, including Commercial Driver Licenses
- Fed Med Card renewals (for Tier 1 CDL drivers)
- School bus physical and testing requirement reminders
- HazMat renewals
- Special Announcements about rule/policy changes effecting driver licenses or plate renewals
