## FMCSA Extends Waiver Information for Commercial Driver Programs

In [notices](#) dated December 15, 2020, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) has updated waiver information for its commercial driver programs. Most of the updated documents include extensions of previous waivers through February 28, 2021 as applicable and extend waivers that otherwise would have expired on December 31, 2020 (or the end of the Presidential Declaration of National Emergency, whichever comes first).
