FMCSA Extends Compliance Date for Entry-Level Driver Training

The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), has [issued](#) a final rule finalizing the extension of the compliance date for the Entry-Level Driver Training (ELDT) final rule from February 7, 2020, to **February 7, 2022**. This action provides FMCSA additional time to complete development of the Training Provider Registry (TPR) and provides State Driver Licensing Agencies (SDLAs) time to modify their information technology systems and procedures, as necessary, to accommodate their receipt of driver-specific ELDT data from the TPR.
