DHS Extends Comment Period for mDL Request for Information

The United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) [has reopened](#) the comment period for its request for information on “Minimum Standards for Driver’s Licenses and Identification Cards Acceptable by Federal Agencies for Official Purposes; Mobile Driver’s Licenses.” DHS notes that the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) is making a view-only version of draft industry standard IEC 18013-5 available to the public which may provide additional insight.

To access a read-only version of the standard, ANSI advises that you visit the following website: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/DQVJYMK> (a nongovernment website). The 18013-5 standard has gone to final ballot and was approved by ISO WG10 with the expectation that it will be formally published at the end of this month.

DHS is reopening the public comment period associated with the RFI ([Docket No. DHS-2020-0028](#)) until **October 18, 2021**.
