NHTSA Requests Comments on Automated Driving System (ADS) Safety

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) has published an [Advanced Notice of Proposed Rulemaking](#) (ANPRM) requesting comment on the development of a framework for Automated Driving System (ADS) safety. The framework seeks to objectively define, assess, and manage the safety of ADS performance while enabling further innovation. NHTSA is looking to draw on existing federal and non-federal foundational efforts and tools in structuring the framework as ADS continues to develop. NHTSA seeks specific feedback on key components that can meet the need for motor vehicle safety while enabling innovative designs in a manner consistent with agency authorities. The ANPRM contains 24 specific questions from NHTSA covering a wide range of topics and beginning on page 78073.

Written comments are due no later than **February 1, 2021**. AAMVA encourages members to provide a copy of their own comments to governmentaffairs@aamva.org so that the organization may reflect those comments in their own.
