### TSA Extends TWIC Expiration Dates

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has [issued](#) a temporary exemption on the expiration of qualifying Transportation Worker Identification Credentials (TWICs). Through this action, TSA will extend the expiration date of TWICs that expired on or after March 1, 2020 by 180 days. The extension of the expiration date remains in effect through **July 31, 2020** unless otherwise modified by TSA through notice published in the Federal Register.

TSA records indicate that there are 2,294,797 active TWICs in circulation today, and that 234,536 (or approximately 10% of them) will expire in the next six months. TSA has issued this extension in response to guidance on COVID-19 health practices and the necessity to continue operational movement of essential goods.
