DHS Funding Will Not Impact AAMVA Applications

As Congress continues to debate both short term (HJ Res 35) and full year (HR 240) Department of Homeland Security (DHS) funding measures, AAMVA wants to reassure its membership that AAMVA applications will not be affected if Congress does not pass a funding measure. AAMVA has confirmed with DHS that both the Records and Information from DMVs for E-Verify (RIDE) system and the Verification of Lawful Status (VLS) system will continue to function normally regardless of funding decisions. AAMVA has also received DHS assurances that the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) system will not be impacted.

Two paths forward currently exist for DHS funding: The United States Senate has cleared an amended, "clean" version of fiscal year 2015 spending for DHS which is being sent to the United States House of Representatives. The House has simultaneously passed a short-term continuing resolution that would fund the department through March 19. At issue in previous versions of DHS spending measures were amendment provisions that would defund activities associated with President Obama's executive actions on immigration – actions that would have expanded the classifications of immigrants eligible for relief from deportation and a provision of legal status.
