Congress Extends Transportation Authorization Until December 4th

The United States Congress has passed legislation extending the current surface transportation authorization until December 4, 2015. The current extension is scheduled to expire on November 20, 2015. The additional extension will provide the House and Senate with sufficient time to consider the amended Senate bill (HR 22) that was taken into conference on November 10th. AAMVA has provided full member-specific [legislative analyses](#) of all phases of the legislation. This includes the bill as it went into conference as a combination of both the Senate's initial measure (HR 22) as passed in July and the House's measure (HR 3763) as introduced and then rolled into the House-amended HR 22 on November 5th. This extension will also allow legislators to carefully resolve any conference issues between the bills and identify additional funding sources, such as the liquidation of the Federal Reserve surplus, to bolster the funding levels of the legislation.
