1 Description of Trigger or Reason for the Change Proposal

ACD codes A04 and A94 were created exclusively for use in convictions involving driving or operating a CMV, as such they must have the hazmat indicator set to a value of 1 or 2 if the citation date is on or after January 1, 2008. This rule is not explicit in the current version of the ACD Manual.
