# State User Fees

## FY2013 Fees

- All states are paying

### *Consumer Access Revenue Credits:*

- DOJ direction:
  - **Feb 2013** - letter to states eligible to received credits toward state fees from consumer access revenues
  - **May 2013** - Notice outlining allowable used for credits, depending upon level of participation
    - Annual NMVTIS fees/ NMVTIS related enhancements/costs
    - Development of capability to fully participate – inquiry



# State User Fees *cont'd*

## FY 2013 *cont'd*

- **May 2013**
  - AAMVA issued:
    - Memo to Chief Administrators outlining the administrative procedures for using credits.
    - New "Credit Statement" – to billing contacts

## FY2014 Fees

- Notification sent to states - Sept. 30, 2012

## FY 2015 Fees

- Recommendation to AAMVA Board – August 2013

## Outstanding Reengineering Issues

- Provide JSI data to online states
- Provide detailed title data (including owner name) from state of title in SWI
- New Web Services – for states, other stakeholders



## State Program

- **34** states fully participating
- **8** states providing data only
- **9** states in development
- State Business Rules WG – best practices document
- Tweaking and streamlining application development procedures
- Developing approaches to enhancing data integrity
  - Duplicate VIN resolution protocol; Data Synchronization

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Party (JSI) Program

Over 59 million records since April, 2009

### JSI Program Working Group

- Being established. Draft charter prepared for review/approval. Membership would include representatives from various JSI program stakeholders

### JSI Program Review continues

- Exploring impact of states reporting on behalf of scrap yards, dismantlers, recyclers, etc.



# Consumer Access Program

- Ten Approved Data Providers
- One in development
- Program review underway
- Suspension on adding any new providers in placed on adding new providers
- **Inquiry volumes:**
  - 2009 – 48,000
  - 2012 – 3.3 million
  - 2013 – 1.4 million (YTD)

## Other

### Annual Report:

- Under development
- Publication scheduled for August 2013

### DOJ's NMVTIS Advisory Board:

- Subcommittee: *"Compliance and Awareness"*
  - Looking at ways to assist/encourage states to fully comply
  - Outreach conducted with 8 data providing and 9 in development states.

# E-Titling Task Force

AAMVA Vehicle Committee E-Titling Working Group is part of a larger whole for the Proof of Concept: E-Title Task Force which includes additional stakeholders:

- Dealers
- Floor Planners
- Lien holders

- Fleet owners
- Insurance Industry
- NICB
- Federal Stakeholders (NHTSA & DOJ)



# E-Titling Proof of Concept

May 2012 the E-Titling Task Force developed scope for a Proof of Concept that would attempt to demonstrate the viability of an electronic titling process.

Proof of concept through AAMVA because:

- Request from the members
- Efficiency through use of existing infrastructure (i.e., network connectivity, NMVTIS and ELT)
- Neutral/standardized interstate transacting
- 2012-2014 Strategic Plan “sweet spot”





# E-Titling Proof of Concept Goal

Demonstrate cost savings, process efficiencies and reduction in fraud by implementing technology and procedures to use electronic records to track a new vehicle from its manufacturer to its first title issuance.

## Approach:

- Remain a state-initiated and state-controlled program
- To the extent possible, use or adapt existing tools or systems including those:
  - Under direct state control
  - Provided by industry
  - Controlled by the Federal Government
- Comply with both State and Federal Regulations
- Collaborate with industry stakeholders to gain their input



# E-Titling Proof of Concept Status

- Deliverables finalized:
  - ✓ E-Titling Data Definition document
  - ✓ MCO Verification Requirements
  - ✓ MCO Verification Design document
- Developing MOA for NICB
- Interstate challenges:
  - Dealer reassignments
  - Electronic Odometer Disclosure



# E-Titling Proof of Concept Schedule

- July 2012 through May 2013: Prepare infrastructure and data integration standards
- May 2013 through December 2013: Pilot participants implementation
- December 2013 through August 2014: Pilot operation and evaluation
