**NOTICE OF SUSPENSION AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

The Secretary of State\* is suspending your driving privileges as of the effective date and for the suspension period referenced above as a result of your conviction for: OPERATING WITHOUT LICENSE by the Sagadahoc County Superior Court, Maine on July 12, 2016. If you have been issued a valid State of Maine drivers license, you are hereby ordered to return your license to this office by the suspension effective date indicated above.

You may request a hearing to show why you should not be suspended.\*\* You may call (207) 624-9000 ext. 52113 to ask for a hearing by telephone, or you may appear on Wednesdays at Bureau of Motor Vehicles, 101 Hospital Street, Augusta, Maine 04333. Hearings are held on a walk-in basis Wednesdays only from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., and from 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. (except legal holidays).

**HOW TO GET YOUR PRIVILEGES BACK**

- 1) Complete and return the enclosed document with a reinstatement fee of \$50.00 to the Secretary of State.
- 2) Satisfy any other suspension that may be in effect.

**IMPORTANT**

You may not drive until you receive written notice that your license or privilege to operate has been restored. The further operation by you of any motor vehicle, until your right to operate has been restored, will be in violation of the laws of this state for which you will be liable to arrest and prosecution.
