SAVE Turns 30!

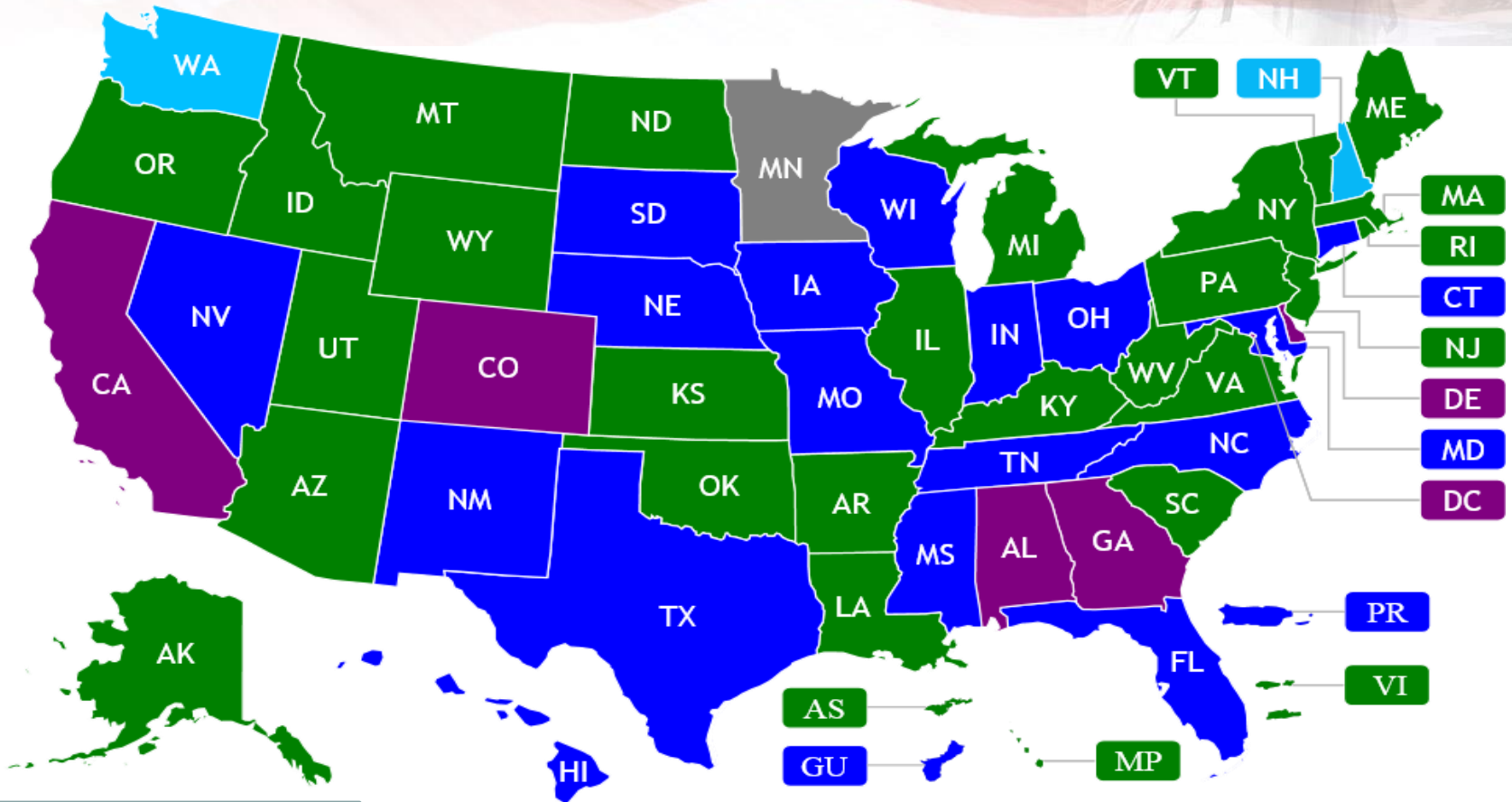
- SAVE was established by the Immigration Reform and Control Act (IRCA) in 1986
- SAVE has processed over **225 million** immigration verifications in its existence
- From modem to mainframe to the world wide web, SAVE has come a long way– and we want to thank you for partnering with us on this journey!

SAVE Connections Upgrades Needed

- SAVE Releases System Enhancements Regularly
 - Enhancements are available immediately in the SAVE Web interface
 - For Web Services and VLS-using agencies, each enhancement must be built into your interface
 - ❖ Agencies with Web Services are required to upgrade **within 18 months** of a new Release.
 - New functions available: Photo Tool, Scan and Upload, Auto 2nd Step, and lots more!
 - Enhanced connections provide more information, higher success rates, and improved security



Upcoming Changes

■ Case Alerts

- Currently SAVE users must check back often on cases awaiting additional verification responses
- Targeted for this Fall, SAVE will implement Case Alerts:
 - ❖ Allows users to receive an alert when a response is received from DHS for one of their cases
 - ❖ Configurable to allow each user to turn on or off the Case Alerts function
 - ❖ Improves efficiency and will speed up benefit granting process



Paper Processing Elimination

- SAVE Announces Sunset Date for Paper Processing
 - SAVE will stop accepting paper-based documents for immigration verification beginning **May, 2018**
 - This includes 3rd Step G-845's with the copies of immigration documents, as well as the original 1st Step G-845 verifications
 - All agencies will need to use the scan-and-upload feature to submit documentation when prompted
 - Moving away from paper processing improves data security, application processing times, and saves trees and ink
