Prior to that appointment, Ms. Nizer served as the MVA’s Chief Deputy Administrator and Deputy Administrator for Central Operations and Safety Programs for over eight years. She also held management positions at the Maryland Public Service Commission, the Maryland General Assembly and the Office of Homeland Security.

In addition to her AAMVA involvement, Ms. Nizer is a 2011 graduate of the Leadership Maryland Program and was named Woman of the Year by the Women in Transportation Seminar Baltimore Chapter in 2014.
