AAMVA Welcomes Nebraska Official as Chair of the AAMVA International Board of Directors

Arlington, VA – During the 2018 AAMVA Annual International Conference in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) elected Rhonda Lahm, Director of the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles, as Chair of its International Board of Directors.

Over the past year, Lahm led the committee tasked with updating AAMVA’s Strategic Framework, guiding the association’s activities and initiatives for the future, and helping AAMVA members to tackle the challenges and opportunities that lie ahead. Lahm also previously served as a President of the AAMVA Region 3 Board as well as a general member of the International Board.

“AAMVA is very excited to have Rhonda Lahm coming on board as our new Chair,” said Anne S. Ferro, AAMVA President and CEO. “Her enthusiasm and many years of experience promoting highway safety both in Nebraska and across North America will benefit AAMVA greatly in the forthcoming year.”

Rhonda Lahm was appointed Director of the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles on February 1, 2013, and was reappointed by the new administration of Governor Pete Ricketts in January of 2015. Prior to her appointment as Director, Lahm served for over twenty-five years as a sworn officer with the Nebraska State Patrol, retiring at the rank of Major. In addition to her extensive contributions to AAMVA’s leadership, she served as a member of State Emergency Response Commission, Domestic Violence Task Force and Nebraska Public Employees Retirement Board.

Lahm is a graduate of Nebraska Wesleyan University with a degree in Biology and Natural Sciences. She received a Master’s degree in Leadership and Management from Doane College.
