AAMVA Welcomes Texas Official as Chair of the AAMVA International Board of Directors

Arlington, VA – During the 2019 AAMVA Annual International Conference in Omaha, Nebraska, the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) elected Whitney Brewster, Executive Director of the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles, as Chair of its International Board of Directors.

“AAMVA is very excited to have Whitney Brewster coming on board as our new Chair,” said Anne S. Ferro, AAMVA President and CEO. “Her keen focus on collaboration and many years of experience promoting highway safety both in Texas and across North America will benefit AAMVA greatly in the forthcoming year.”

Whitney Brewster is the executive director of the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles. She is the second executive director to lead the agency since its inception in 2009. She oversees an agency with 800 employees, a biennial budget of over \$300 million and more than \$1.8 billion in annual revenue collections for the state.

Brewster grew up in Houston, but began her professional career in Alaska. She served five years as director of Alaska’s Division of Motor Vehicles. Past positions in Alaska include Division of Elections director, the lieutenant governor’s deputy chief of staff and working for the state legislature. She also currently serves on the AAMVA Region 2 Board.

Founded in 1933, AAMVA serves North American motor vehicle and law enforcement agencies to accomplish their missions. The association’s vision - *Safe Drivers, Safe Vehicles, Secure Identities, Saving Lives* - guides AAMVA’s activities, resources, and programs in driver licensing, vehicle titling/registration, motor carrier services, identity management, and technology solutions.
